

CHECKLIST APPLICATION PACKAGE NETHERLANDS REGISTER OF COURT EXPERTS – LEGAL PSYCHOLOGY

Please use this list below to check that you have filled in the NRGD Application Package completely and accurately. You are asked to submit a complete application. An incomplete or inaccurate application will result in delay of the procedure. The application process formally begins when the NRGD has received all the required documentation.

Initial independent reporter

- An original Certificate of Good Conduct or Integrity Statement
- A legible photocopy of a valid passport or ID card
- A Curriculum Vitae (CV), preferably in English
- Copies of certificates for the highest academic qualification
- List of case information Legal Psychology with a minimum of 5 case reports completed in the preceding 5 years that have been collegially reviewed. For each subfield to which the application relates, the reporter should list at least 2 case reports.
- A minimum of 3 case reports selected from the list of case information. For each subfield to which the application relates, the reporter should submit at least 2 case reports. When several subfields are combined in one case report, it is possible to provide the same case report for different subfields (009.1 – 009.3). The case reports should provide a clear and broad picture of the applicant's competences.
- An overview of forensically relevant continued professional development with an average of 40 hours per year in the past 5 years.
- If available:
 - Evidence of continued professional development;
 - Copies of relevant certificates and evidence of contributions to the relevant academic knowledge base and debate.

Initial reporter without work of his own

- Statement accompanying the NRGD Application Form
- An original Certificate of Good Conduct or Integrity Statement
- A legible photocopy of a valid passport or ID card
- A Curriculum Vitae (CV), preferably in English
- Copies of certificates for the highest academic qualification
- List of case information Legal Psychology with a minimum of 3 case reports that have been drawn up under supervision. For each subfield to which the application relates, the reporter should list at least 2 case reports.
- A minimum of 3 case reports selected from the list of case information. For each subfield

to which the application relates, the reporter should submit at least 2 case reports. When several subfields are combined in one case report, it is possible to provide the same case report for different subfields (009.1 – 009.3). The case reports should provide a clear and broad picture of the applicant's competences.

- An overview of forensically relevant continued professional development with an average of 40 hours per year in the past 5 years.
- If available:
 - o Evidence of continued professional development;
 - o Copies of relevant certificates and evidence of contributions to the relevant academic knowledge base and debate.

- A minimum of 2 case reports selected from the list of case information. For each subfield to which the application relates, the reporter should submit at least 2 case reports. When several subfields are combined in one case report, it is possible to provide the same case report for different subfields (009.1 – 009.3).
- An overview of forensically relevant continued professional development with an average of 40 hours per year in the past 2 years.
- If available, evidence of continued professional development.

Short explanation of some of the items on the Checklist

Certificate of Good Conduct or Integrity Statement

The Certificate of Good Conduct may be submitted at a later time (see the Explanatory Notes accompanying the NRGD Application Package). If you do not live in the Netherlands or have lived in the Netherlands for less than four years, please read the Explanatory Notes accompanying the NRGD Application Package.

Photocopy of a valid passport or ID card

If you reside in the EU and your passport or ID card has been issued outside the EU, please also submit a copy of a valid residence permit.

List of case information

Please make sure that the list of case information and/or case report(s) selected by you is as representative as possible of your competencies.
